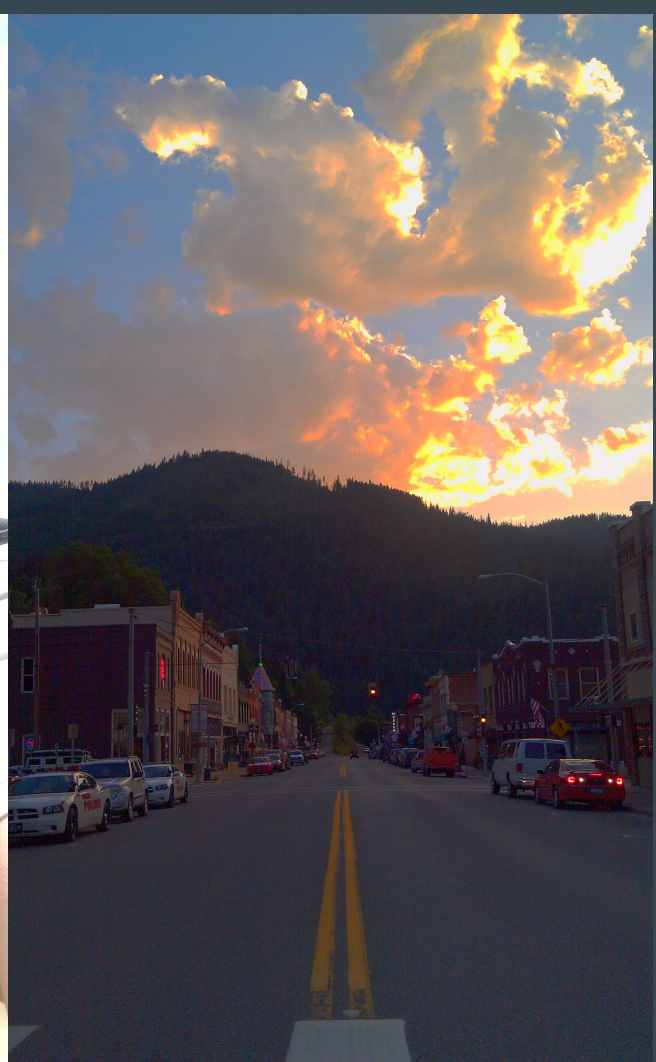

We encourage you to stay the night as lodging is plentiful at the Wallace Inn, Ryan Hotel or turn your overnight stay into an experience at one of the former brothels like the Lux Rooms located above the Silver Corner Bar.

4. Play golf at one or all of our three nine-hole golf courses; Pinehurst Golf Course, Shoshone Golf Course or Galena Ridge Golf Course.
5. Bicycle from Wallace to Mullan via the Trail of the Coeur d'Alenes. It's a great workout because it's a gradual uphill climb and then reward yourself with a yummy Outlaw burger and a cold beer at the Outlaw Bar & Grill on Hunter Avenue in Mullan.
6. Ski both Lookout Pass Recreation Area and Silver Mountain!
7. Visit our three breweries; Radio Brewing Company in Kellogg, Wallace Brewing Company and City Limits Pub/North Idaho Mountain Brew in Wallace and try their craft beer flights.
