EDA 101 – or how do I apply for some of those ARPA dollars?

EDA Overview

Mission

EDA's mission is to lead the federal economic development agenda by promoting innovation and competitiveness

EDA supports regional economic development through their grants processes – partnering with communities to leverage private sector investment and the creation of high-wage, high demand jobs.



American Rescue Plan Act

SEC. 6001. ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE.

- (a) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION APPROPRIATION.—There is appropriated for fiscal year 2021, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$3,000,000,000 to the Department of Commerce for economic adjustment assistance to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus and for necessary expenses for responding to economic injury as a result of coronavirus.
- (c) Of the funds provided by this section, 25 percent shall be for assistance to States and communities that have suffered economic injury as a result of job and gross domestic product losses in the travel, tourism, or outdoor recreation sectors.



Grant Requirements

- Eligible EDA Applicants/Grantees:
 - District Organization;
 - Indian Tribe or a consortium of Indian Tribes;
 - State, county, city, or other political subdivision of a State;
 - Institution of higher education or a consortium of institutions of higher education; or
 - Public or private non-profit organization or association acting in cooperation with officials of a political subdivision of a State
- EDA does not provide investments to for-profit entities, nor does it allow pass through of grant funds to private, for-profit companies

How to apply?

- At this time, it's not known how EDA will be distributing the tourism-related set-aside.
- Under consideration are block grants to states for sub-awards, or our traditional process that awards to individual communities and organizations.
- We are anticipating that program guidance to be issued in May.
- To be prepared -- EDA uses Grants.gov a website that will require that you register prior to being able to submit your application.
- You can preview the requirements to collect the information that your project proposal will need to be competitive.

Grants.gov – In the search box (upper right hand corner) type PWEAA, that should take you to:

Let's talk budget

Match (or the non-federal share)

- The CARES Act required a 20% match we anticipate that there will be a similar requirement for the ARPA funding
- Only real cash pays real bills
- In-kind may be okay --- if it directly reduces the amount of real dollars you need to implement your scope of work
- EDA is a reimbursement program, so you'll need to have the means to fund the project



Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) Connection

- EDA supports regionally-driven economic development
- The roadmap for that is known as a CEDS
- In Idaho, the five Economic Development Districts are recognized as the holders of those plans covering their geographic areas
- Other formal economic strategies may be allowed if they contain a 'comprehensive' analysis of the economy



EDA Performance Measures – Reporting Requirements

- If the project is funded, EDA will ask for information on the economic impacts
- We use an on-line system for collecting that data
- Think about how you will be able to track your project's impacts on revenues, jobs – other measures that can demonstrate the benefits



Tips and Tricks

- Tell your story but back it up with reliable data
- Develop a clear and concise scope of work
- Ditto with your budget
- Think letters of collaboration, not letter of support
