Title: Application Challenge/Rebuttal Process and Idaho CPF Tentatively Awarded Projects Dashboard

Effective Date: Immediate

This notice is meant to provide an update regarding the 17 tentatively awarded projects and the challenge/rebuttal process of those projects. Challenged projects that were not tentatively awarded will not be adjudicated unless the IBAB determines it necessary.

On Tuesday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the Idaho Broadband Advisory Board (IBAB) awarded over \$118 million for 17 projects, pending adjudication of submitted challenges. Of those projects:

- 5 Projects Unchallenged
- 12 Projects Challenged
  - o 4 Project Challenges Dismissed
  - o 3 Projects Adjusted Based on Challenge and Rebuttal
  - o 5 Project Challenges for IBAB Determination

Tentatively awarded applicants were given the opportunity to work with the Idaho Broadband GIS Team to finalize their GIS project map based on challenge project adjustments.

The IBAB will be making determinations regarding the 5 remaining challenges during the <u>December 1</u>, 2023, IBAB meeting.
