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WHY MEXICO CITY?

- The USMCA firmly in place is bolstering the current economic recovery with Mexico
- Mexico is the 2nd largest market for food and agriculture, the current largest trading partner with the U.S., as well as the 6th largest export market.
- Mexico is the 15th largest economy in the world and the second largest economy in Latin America.
- Since the COVID pandemic Mexico has sprung back and is expecting GDP growth in 2023.
- Most of Mexico's population is young with a median age of 29, driving increased consumption and demand for quality food and beverage products.
- · Mexico City's GDP is twice that of Monterrey and 3 times that of Guadalajara
- The US contributes 54% of Mexico's annual imports (CIA World Factbook 2019)
