




IIG/IRON Project IBF


- Idaho County: Nez Perce Tribe Cultural Review complete, No Adverse Effects

 - Collaboration with IIG/IRON & POL to share Point of Presence (POP) location in Grangeville








- Intermax (#7, 9 & 8):





















- Engineering/design and utility coordination is complete.

- Actively engaged in community and open access partnerships outreach. The response to the project has been positive (nearly 80% take rate).





December 2023: Idaho Initial Proposal submitted to NTIA
